# Western Samoa, Niue, and Solomon Islands: Current legislation lists

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Access to the legislation of small jurisdictions is a continuing problem. The material which follows brings the available published lists of legislation up to date and provides basic data on recent legislation of those jurisdictions in an accessible form.

## I. WESTERN SAMOA<sup>1</sup>

## A. Introduction

The last official publication of the legislation of Western Samoa was the *Reprint of the Statutes of Western Samoa 1920-1977* which printed the texts of the statutes and subsidiary legislation as at 1 January 1978.

Subsequently, individual pieces of legislation have been printed by the Government Printer. For most of these pieces of legislation users are reliant on access either to an original or to a photocopy or typed copy of the original.

Access to Western Samoan legislation has been greatly facilitated by the consolidated tables prepared in the office of the Attorney-General as non-official publications. The latest table compiled by Patrick Fepulea'i is reproduced here. It lists the legislation in force on 1 July 1987. The statutes are arranged alphabetically by short title and any subsidiary legislation is also listed. The tables provide readily for the updating of the material in the 1978 *Reprint*.

Volume 6 of the *Reprint* provides a General Index of the Statutes of Western Samoa 1920-1977 of which Part II is a chronological list of Ordinances and Acts enacted between 1920 and 4 March 1981 inclusive. Part IV of the Index provides a chronological list of subsidiary legislation enacted between 1953 and 23 March 1981 inclusive. The compilation by Patrick Fepulea'i brings the alphabetical listings up to date. The

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chronological lists of Western Samoan enactments after March 1981 are presented after the alphabetical lists. Consultation of the lists will enable identification of enactments of likely interest and then, where appropriate, copies can be requested through official channels.

Since the lists in the Index of Volume 6 of the *Reprint* are incomplete for 1981, the chronological lists in part repeat the 1981 data already available, then update the tables of Acts and subsidiary legislation to 1 July 1987.

## II. NIUE<sup>4</sup>

## A. Introduction

The last official collection of the legislation of Niue was the *Laws of Niue 1916-1967*, published by the Ministry of Island Territories, in Wellington. The volume stated the legislation in force in Niue as at 31 March 1967.

Access to the legislation of Niue is greatly facilitated by the *Index to the Laws of Niue in force on 31 March 1972*, published by the Maori and Island Affairs Department, Wellington. The Index brings the alphabetical and chronological lists up to date as at March 1972.

The texts of legislation for the period 1967 to 1972 are in most instances available in the official collections of New Zealand legislation.

On 19 October 1974 Niue attained the status of self-government in free association with New Zealand. Since that date very little legislation of Niue has been published and

there are no publicly available lists either alphabetical or chronological of that legislation.

The problem is further compounded in respect of subsidiary legislation because since 19 October 1974 very little subsidiary legislation has been promulgated in Niue and the information publicly available on that legislation is insufficient to enable the preparation of a full chronological table.

The object of the following tables is to provide a chronological list of the Niue statutes since 31 March 1972 i.e. from the end of the period covered by the Index, and a chronological list of subsidiary legislation from that period based on as much information as is available.

## B. Legislation

## 1. Acts<sup>5</sup>

The numbers in the left hand column are those of the bills and do not indicate the order of enactment. The bills may have been passed out of order or not passed at all.

A general guide to historical sequence can be gained from the year in the short title of the Act.

From 19 October 1974, when Niue attained the status of self-government in free association with New Zealand, enactments were no longer known as Ordinances. This reflects the fact that Niue ceased to be a subordinate legislature, became a sovereign institution and accordingly enacted Acts. At this point also, bills begin from number 1 again.

The latest official, complete edition of the laws of Solomon Islands is *The Laws of the British Solomon Islands Protectorate* published by Sweet & Maxwell Ltd in London in 1971. The six volume series stated the ordinances and subsidiary legislation of the Protectorate in force as at 31 December 1969.

In 1973 these volumes were supplemented by another official publication entitled *Consolidated Statutory Instruments Applicable to the British Solomon Islands Protectorate*, in force as at 31 December 1971; it was published by Sweet and Maxwell, London, in 1973.

In 1970 a series of annual volumes, *The Ordinances of the British Solomon Islands Protectorate* was begun. These volumes detailed ordinances published during the relevant year and incorporated the Legal Supplement containing subsidiary legislation published during that year. The volumes each concluded with a general index, which listed the laws in force as at 31 December of the respective years. For several years the volumes were prepared and received a reasonably wide circulation. However, towards the end of the 1970's the pattern of publication of the annual volumes changed. The series is now some years behind and appears to be available only to local subscribers to the *Solomon Islands Gazette*.

In 1980 the initiative was taken by the Office of the Attorney-General to produce a new text of the laws in loose leaf format entitled *Laws of Solomon Islands*. This system

resulted in some 15 statutes being consolidated and reprinted. The series was discontinued in 1982.

Access to Solomon Islands legislation is now by subscription to the *Solomon Islands Gazette*. All Acts and subsidiary legislation appear in the Legal Supplement to the publication. Given the fact that few libraries are likely to have lists of the legislation in force in Solomon Islands later than for the 1969, six-volume consolidation, the chronological tables which follow, list the statutes enacted between 1 January 1970 and 5 August 1987.

For the same period there is a vast amount of subsidiary legislation but due to time and space limitations it has not been possible to present that information here.
