

## APPROPRIATION ACT, 1866.

IN THE TWENTY-NINTH YEAR OF THE REIGN OF HER  
MAJESTY QUEEN VICTORIA.

1866. SESSION XIX, No. 20.

Title.

*AN ACT to Appropriate the Revenue for the year 1866,*

BE IT ENACTED by the Superintendent of the Province of Auckland with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof as follows:

Short Title.

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Appropriation Act 1866."

Certain sums applied to specified services.

2. Out of the Revenue of the Province of Auckland for the year 1866 subject to the appropriation of the Provincial Council there may be issued and applied for or towards the several services specified in the schedule to this Act any sum or sums of money not exceeding the several sums therein respectively set forth and no part of the said Revenue shall be issued or applied to any other purpose whatever.

Money from land sales in excess of £5,400 applicable to works for which rates or contributions are raised.

3. If the money which shall be received from the sale and disposal of the Waste Lands shall exceed the sum of £5,400 it shall be lawful for the Superintendent to contribute to any road bridge or other work of public utility a sum not exceeding any sum which shall be subscribed or raised by voluntary contribution or by rate for the purpose of making building or carrying out such road bridge or public work.

Salaries and expenses under the Diseased Cattle Acts.

4. To defray the salaries and other expences incidental to "The Diseased Cattle Act 1861" and "The Diseased Cattle Act Amendment Act 1865" for the year 1866 it shall be lawful for the Superintendent to cause to be paid out of the fees arising under the said Acts such salary to any inspector as the Superintendent shall think fit not exceeding in amount the fees received by him during the said year

and also to pay out of the said fees such incidental expenses as the Superintendent shall think necessary.

5. The Provincial Treasurer or other person having charge of the Public Funds of the Province shall issue and pay from time to time any sum of money not exceeding in the whole the sums respectively specified to such person and in such portions as the Superintendent for the time being shall by warrants to be granted by him from time to time direct and such Treasurer or other person having charge of the Public Funds of the Province shall in his accounts be allowed credit for all sums paid by him in pursuance of such warrants and the receipts of the persons to whom such sums shall have been so paid shall be to him a full discharge for the sums for which such receipts shall have been given and the amounts thereof shall be passed to his account accordingly.

6. All money borrowed under the authority of any Act of the Provincial Legislature shall be deemed to be Revenue of the Province of Auckland for the purposes of "The Provincial Audit Act 1861" of the General Assembly.

7. Every person who shall have possession of any Public Funds of this Province is hereby authorised and required to pay the same to the Treasurer thereof or to such other person and in such manner as the Superintendent by warrant granted under his hand shall direct.
