1 Title

This order is the Biosecurity (National Bovine Tuberculosis Pest Management Strategy) Amendment Order (No 2) 2011.

2 Commencement

This order comes into force on the date on which it is notified in the *Gazette*.

3 Principal order amended

This order amends the Biosecurity (National Bovine Tuberculosis Pest Management Strategy) Order 1998.

4 Interpretation

The definition of **cattle** in clause 2(1) is amended by omitting “artiodactyla Bovidae” and substituting “family Bovidae, sub-family Bovinae”.

Explanatory note
