

Coroners (Fees) Amendment Regulations 1997

PURSUANT to section 45 of the Coroners Act 1988, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

1 Title and commencement

- (1) These regulations may be cited as the Coroners (Fees) Amendment Regulations 1997, and are part of the Coroners (Fees) Regulations 1992¹ (“the principal regulations”).
- (2) These regulations come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2 Fees

Regulation 2(3) of the principal regulations is amended by adding the following paragraph:

- “(g) For every laboratory test associated with a post-mortem examination, the fee fourteenthly specified in the Schedule.”

3 Goods and services tax included

The principal regulations are amended by inserting, after regulation 2, the following regulation:

“2A

The fees prescribed by these regulations are inclusive of goods and services tax.”

**Coroners (Fees) Amendment
Regulations 1997**

These regulations increase the fees payable to doctors for post-mortem examinations and related services. The regulations also provide for a new fee payable to doctors for laboratory tests associated with post-mortem examinations.

The fees are inclusive of goods and services tax.
