

## **Copyright (Application to Other Countries) Amendment Order 2000**

Pursuant to sections 204 and 232 of the Copyright Act 1994, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the recommendation of the Minister of Commerce and on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following order.

### **1 Title**

- (1) This order is the Copyright (Application to Other Countries) Amendment Order 2000.
- (2) In this order, the Copyright (Application to Other Countries) Order 1995<sup>1</sup> is called “the principal order”.

### **2 Commencement**

This order comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.
