1 Title and commencement

- (1) These rules may be cited as the Disputes Tribunals Amendment Rules 1998, and are part of the Disputes Tribunals Rules 1989¹ (“the principal rules”).

3 Forms

Form 2 in the Schedule of the principal rules is amended—

- (a) by omitting the expression “\$3,000” in the note under the heading **Agreement to Extend Jurisdiction**, and substituting the expression “\$7,500”; and
- (b) by omitting the expression “\$5,000” in the note under the heading **Agreement to Extend Jurisdiction**, and substituting the expression “\$12,000”.

4 Revocation

The Disputes Tribunals Amendment Rules 1997 (SR 1997/323) are consequentially revoked.
