- 1 Title**  
These rules are the Disputes Tribunals Amendment Rules (No 3) 2001.
- 2 Commencement**  
These rules come into force on 28 September 2001.
- 3 Commencement of Disputes Tribunals Amendment Rules 2001**  
Rule 2 of the Disputes Tribunals Amendment Rules 2001 is amended by omitting the expression “1 October”, and substituting the expression “15 October”.
- 4 Revocation**  
The Disputes Tribunals Amendment Rules (No 2) 2001 (SR 2001/164) are consequentially revoked.
