- 1 Title**

These regulations are the Immigration (Visa, Entry Permission, and Related Matters) Amendment Regulations (No 3) 2013.
- 2 Commencement**

These regulations come into force on 9 September 2013.
- 3 Principal regulations**

These regulations amend the Immigration (Visa, Entry Permission, and Related Matters) Regulations 2010 (the **principal regulations**).
- 4 Schedule 4 amended**

In Schedule 4, item relating to regulations 10(1)(a) and 12(1) and (3)(g), replace “140” with “165” in each place.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 9 September 2013, amend the Immigration (Visa, Entry Permission, and Related Matters) Regulations 2010. The regulations increase the application fee, from \$140 to \$165, for visas relating to working holiday schemes where the application must be made online. This aligns the application fee with other application fees for visas relating to working holiday schemes.
