Pursuant to section 3 of the Invercargill Licensing Trust Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

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## **Order**

- 1 Title and commencement**
    - (1) This order may be cited as the Invercargill Licensing Trust District Order 1974.
    - (2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.
  
  - 2 Invercargill Licensing Trust District redefined**

The boundaries of the Invercargill Licensing Trust District are hereby altered so as to make them the same as the boundaries of the City of Invercargill, and to that intent the boundaries of the Invercargill Licensing Trust are hereby redefined in the manner set out in the Schedule.
  
  - 3 Revocation**

The Invercargill Licensing Trust District Order 1970 (SR 1970/181) is hereby revoked.
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## **Schedule**

### **Boundaries of the Invercargill Licensing Trust District**

All that area in the Southland Land District containing 5 574 hectares, more or less, bounded by a line commencing at the south-eastern corner of part Section 33, Block XV, Invercargill Hundred, and proceeding northerly along the eastern boundaries of that part Section 33 and Lot 1, DP 4400, to Bay Road, along a right line to and along the eastern boundary of Lot 3, DP 6960, to a point 500 links south of the northern side of Heywood Street; thence westerly along a right line to a point on the western boundary of Lot 1, DP 6960, 500 links south of the north-western corner of that lot; thence northerly along

the western boundaries of Lot 1, DP 6960, and Lot 1, DP 6686, to a point in line with the northern boundary of Lot 16, DP 4265 (Grasmere Domain, *New Zealand Gazette*, 1955, p 1767); thence easterly along a right line to the north-western corner of that Lot 16; thence northerly along the eastern boundary of Lot 1, DP 6686, and its production to the middle of Renfrew Street; thence easterly along the middle of Renfrew Street to a point in line with the middle of Sussex Street; thence northerly to and along the middle of Sussex Street to a point in line with the southern boundary of Section 52, Block XV, Invercargill Hundred; thence westerly to and along that boundary and the southern boundary of Section 53, Block XV, Invercargill Hundred, to the western boundary of that section; thence northerly along that boundary and its production to and along the western boundary of Section 38, Block XV, Invercargill Hundred, to the southern side of West Plains Road; thence easterly along that roadside to the middle of Sussex Street; thence northerly along the middle of Sussex Street produced to the middle of West Plains Road; thence easterly along the middle of West Plains Road to a point in line with the western boundary of Lot 8, DP 5824; thence northerly along a right line to the south-western corner of that Lot 8; thence easterly along the southern boundaries of Lots 8 and 9, DP 5824, along a right line to and along the southern boundary of Lot 10, DP 5824, to its easternmost point; thence northerly along the eastern boundary of the said Lot 10 to the southern boundary of Lot 4, DP 2323; thence easterly along that last-mentioned boundary and its production to the eastern side of No 6 State Highway; thence southerly along the western boundary of Lot 2, DP 4209, and its production to a point in line with the western boundary of Lot 1, DP 3739; thence along a right line to the north-western corner of that Lot 1; thence easterly and southerly along the northern and eastern boundaries of Lot 1 aforesaid and the last-mentioned boundary produced to a point in line with the northern boundary of part Lot 26, DP 5; thence easterly to and along that boundary to the western boundary of part Section 15, Block VI, Invercargill Hundred; thence southerly along that boundary and the western boundaries of Lots 1 and 2, DP 431, and part Section 15, aforesaid to a line parallel to, and 250 links north of, the northern side of Bainfield Road; thence easterly along that line to its intersection with the production of another line parallel to, and 250 links east of, the eastern side of Queens Drive, as defined on

DP 2176; thence southerly to and along that line and lines parallel to, and 250 links east of, the eastern side of Queens Drive, as defined on DP 2498, to the north-eastern boundary of part Section 10, Block IV, Invercargill Hundred; thence south-easterly and southerly along the north-eastern and eastern boundaries of part Section 10 aforesaid to the generally northern boundary of Section 89, Block I, Invercargill Hundred; thence easterly generally along that boundary and the right (north) bank of the old Waihopai River to its intersection with the centre line of the new channel of that river, defined as Section 59 on SO Plan 6730; thence easterly along that centre line and its production to its intersection with a line parallel to, and 300 links north-east of, the original centre line of Racecourse Road, as defined on SO Plans 6356 and 200; thence south-easterly along that line to the south-eastern boundary of part Section 2, Block II, Invercargill Hundred; thence north-easterly along that boundary to a line parallel to, and 350 links north-east of, the original centre line of Racecourse Road, as defined on SO Plan 200; thence south-easterly along that line to the south-eastern boundary of Lot 1, DP 5061; thence north-easterly along that boundary to the south-western boundary of Lot 1, DP 7091; thence south-easterly along that boundary and its production to the original centre line of Findlay Road, as defined on SO Plan 200; thence south-westerly along that centre line to a point in line with the south-western boundary of Lot 4, DP 4356; thence north-westerly along a right line to the north-western side of Findlay Road; thence south-westerly along that roadside to a line parallel to, and 250 links north-east of, the centre line of Racecourse Road as defined on SO Plan 200; thence south-easterly along that line to the south-eastern boundary of Section 6, Block II, Invercargill Hundred; thence north-easterly along that boundary to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary of Lot 1, DP 4597; thence south-easterly to the northernmost corner of Lot 1, DP 4597 thence north-easterly and south-easterly along the north-western and north-eastern boundaries of part Lots 3 and 4, DP 153, to the northern side of No 1 State Highway; thence south-westerly along that roadside and its production to a point in line with the centre line of Rockdale Road as defined on SO Plan 200; thence south-easterly to and along that centre line to a point in line with the north-western boundary of Section 44, Block II, Invercargill Hundred; thence north-easterly to and along that boundary to its northernmost point; thence south-easterly and south-west-

erly along the north-eastern and south-eastern boundaries of Section 44 aforesaid to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary of Lot 8, deeds register plan 63; thence south-easterly to and along that boundary to the north-western boundary of the eastern part of Section 72, Block II, Invercargill Hundred; thence south-westerly and south-easterly along the north-western and south-western boundaries of the said eastern part of Section 72 to the easternmost corner of the western part of Section 72 aforesaid; thence south-westerly along the south-eastern boundary of the said western part of Section 72 to the north-eastern boundary of Section 82, Block XXII, Invercargill Hundred; thence south-easterly along that boundary to Mason Road; thence due south to the northern side of Lardner Road; thence easterly along that roadside to a point in line with the western boundary of Section 9B, Block XXII, Invercargill Hundred; thence southerly to and along the western boundaries of Sections 9B, 9A and 13, Block XXII, Invercargill Hundred, and the last-mentioned boundary produced to its intersection with a line parallel to, and 300 links south of, the centre line of Wixon Road; thence westerly along that line to the eastern boundary of part Section 15, Block XXII, Invercargill Hundred; thence southerly and north-westerly along the eastern and south-western boundaries of that section to a point due north of the northernmost corner of the land on DP 1585; thence due south to that corner; thence south-westerly along the north-western boundary of the land on DP 1585 to the northern boundary of part Lot 1, DP 561; thence westerly along that boundary to a line parallel to, and 275 links east of, the centre line of Tisbury Motu Rimu Road; thence southerly along that line to its intersection with the production of another line parallel to, and 275 links south of, the centre line of Avon Road; thence westerly to and along that line to the middle of Ferguson Street; thence south-easterly along the centre line of Ferguson Street to a point in line with the north-western boundary of part Section 50, Block XIX, Invercargill Hundred; thence south-westerly to and along that boundary to No 1 State Highway; thence north-westerly along the north-western side of that highway to a point in line with the north-western boundary of Section 21, Block XIX, Invercargill Hundred; thence south-westerly to and along that boundary and its production to and along the north-western boundary of Section 13, Block XIX, Invercargill Hundred, to its westernmost point; thence north-westerly along a right line to the easternmost corner of

Section 127, Block XX, Invercargill Hundred; thence north-west-erly generally along the north-eastern boundary of that section the south-western boundary of Section 137, Block XX aforesaid, and generally north-eastern side of Curran Road to Otatara Road; thence north-easterly along the south-eastern side of Otatara Road and the south-eastern boundaries of Lot 1, DP 6248 and Section 176, Block XV, Invercargill Hundred, to the south-western boundary of Lot 9, DP 822; thence south-easterly along that boundary to its southern-most point; thence north-easterly along the south-eastern boundaries of Lots 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, and 4, and part Lots 3, 2, and 1, DP 822, and Section 158, Block XV, Invercargill Hundred, the south-eastern end of a public road and the south-eastern boundaries of Sections 32 and part 33, Block XV, Invercargill Hundred to the point of commencement.

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## **Notes**

### **1 *General***

This is a reprint of the Invercargill Licensing Trust District Order 1974. The reprint incorporates all the amendments to the order as at 7 June 1974, as specified in the list of amendments at the end of these notes.

Relevant provisions of any amending enactments that contain transitional, savings, or application provisions that cannot be compiled in the reprint are also included, after the principal enactment, in chronological order. For more information, *see* <http://www.pco.parliament.govt.nz/reprints/>.

### **2 *Status of reprints***

Under section 16D of the Acts and Regulations Publication Act 1989, reprints are presumed to correctly state, as at the date of the reprint, the law enacted by the principal enactment and by the amendments to that enactment. This presumption applies even though editorial changes authorised by section 17C of the Acts and Regulations Publication Act 1989 have been made in the reprint.

This presumption may be rebutted by producing the official volumes of statutes or statutory regulations in which the principal enactment and its amendments are contained.

### **3 *How reprints are prepared***

A number of editorial conventions are followed in the preparation of reprints. For example, the enacting words are not included in Acts, and provisions that are repealed or revoked

#### **4 Changes made under section 17C of the Acts and Regulations Publication Act 1989**

Section 17C of the Acts and Regulations Publication Act 1989 authorises the making of editorial changes in a reprint as set out in sections 17D and 17E of that Act so that, to the extent permitted, the format and style of the reprinted enactment is consistent with current legislative drafting practice. Changes that would alter the effect of the legislation are not permitted. A new format of legislation was introduced on 1 January 2000. Changes to legislative drafting style have also been made since 1997, and are ongoing. To the extent permitted by section 17C of the Acts and Regulations Publication Act 1989, all legislation reprinted after 1 January 2000 is in the new format for legislation and reflects current drafting practice at the time of the reprint.

In outline, the editorial changes made in reprints under the authority of section 17C of the Acts and Regulations Publication Act 1989 are set out below, and they have been applied, where relevant, in the preparation of this reprint:

- omission of unnecessary referential words (such as “of this section” and “of this Act”)
- typeface and type size (Times Roman, generally in 11.5 point)
- layout of provisions, including:
  - indentation
  - position of section headings (eg, the number and heading now appear above the section)
- format of definitions (eg, the defined term now appears in bold type, without quotation marks)
- format of dates (eg, a date formerly expressed as “the 1st day of January 1999” is now expressed as “1 January 1999”)

- position of the date of assent (it now appears on the front page of each Act)
- punctuation (eg, colons are not used after definitions)
- Parts numbered with roman numerals are replaced with arabic numerals, and all cross-references are changed accordingly
- case and appearance of letters and words, including:
  - format of headings (eg, headings where each word formerly appeared with an initial capital letter followed by small capital letters are amended so that the heading appears in bold, with only the first word (and any proper nouns) appearing with an initial capital letter)
  - small capital letters in section and subsection references are now capital letters
- schedules are renumbered (eg, Schedule 1 replaces First Schedule), and all cross-references are changed accordingly
- running heads (the information that appears at the top of each page)
- format of two-column schedules of consequential amendments, and schedules of repeals (eg, they are rearranged into alphabetical order, rather than chronological).
