#### **1 Title**

- (1) This notice is the Injury Prevention, Rehabilitation, and Compensation (Accredited Employers Framework) Amendment Notice 2005.
- (2) In this notice, the Framework for the Accredited Employers Programme<sup>1</sup> is called “the principal notice”.

#### **2 Commencement**

This notice comes into force on 1 April 2005.

#### **3 Premium**

Paragraph 6.7 of the principal notice is amended by—

- (a) omitting the words “For the purpose of calculating such discount the following steps are to be taken:” ; and

This notice, which comes into force on 1 April 2005, amends paragraph 6.7 of the Framework for the Accredited Employers Programme.

The amendments remove the detailed, but incorrect, method of calculating the Partnership Discount Plan discount.
