PURSUANT to section 4 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

Order

1 Title and commencement

- (1) This order may be cited as the Misuse of Drugs Order 1981.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2 Schedule 1 of Act amended

Schedule 1 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975 is hereby amended by inserting in clause 1, in their appropriate alphabetical order, the following names of substances:

“PCE (N-ethyl-1-phenylcyclohexylamine).

“PCPY}

“PHP} (1-(1-phenylcyclohexyl) pyrrolidine).

“TCP (1-[1-(2-thienyl) cyclohexyl] piperidine).”

3 Schedule 2 of Act amended

(1) *[Revoked]*

(2) Part 3 of Schedule 2 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975 is hereby amended by inserting in clause 1, in their appropriate alphabetical order, the names of the following substances:

“MECLOQUALONE (3-(2-chlorophenyl)-2-methyl-4(3H)-quinazolinone).

“SUFENTANIL-(N-[4 (methoxymethyl)-1-[2-(2-thienyl) ethyl]-4-piperidyl] propionanilide).

“TILIDINE ((±)-ethyl *trans*-2-(dimethylamino)-1-phenyl-3-cyclohexene-1-carboxylate).”

4 Schedule 3 of Act amended

Part 1 of Schedule 3 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975 is hereby amended by inserting in clause 1, in its appropriate alphabetical order, the name of the substance “*Catha edulis* plant”.
