

## **Misuse of Drugs (Changes to Controlled Drugs) Order Commencement Order 2005**

Pursuant to section 4A(1) of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975 and a resolution of the House of Representatives made on 2 August 2005 in accordance with section 4A(3) of that Act, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following order.

**1 Title**  
This order is the Misuse of Drugs (Changes to Controlled Drugs) Order Commencement Order 2005.

**2 Commencement of Misuse of Drugs (Changes to Controlled Drugs) Order 2005**  
The Misuse of Drugs (Changes to Controlled Drugs) Order 2005 (SR 2005/175) comes into force on 9 September 2005.

### **Explanatory note**

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order brings the Misuse of Drugs (Changes to Controlled Drugs) Order 2005 into force on 9 September 2005. That order amends Schedule 2 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975 in order to reclassify amphetamine and MDMA as controlled drugs in Part 1 of Schedule 2 (“Class B1” controlled drugs). Their former classification was as controlled drugs in Part 2 of Schedule 2 (“Class B2” controlled drugs).

The order requires the approval of the House of Representatives before it comes into force. The House of Representatives approved the order on 2 August 2005.
