### 2 Commencement of sections 32 and 33 of New Zealand Geographic Board (Ngā Pou Taunaha o Aotearoa) Act 2008

Sections 32 and 33 of the New Zealand Geographic Board (Ngā Pou Taunaha o Aotearoa) Act 2008 come into force on 1 November 2009.

## Explanatory note

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order brings sections 32 and 33 of the New Zealand Geographic Board (Ngā Pou Taunaha o Aotearoa) Act 2008 into force. These are the two provisions not brought into force by the New Zealand Geographic Board (Ngā Pou Taunaha o Aotearoa) Act Commencement Order 2008.

Section 32 requires official names to be used in official documents and section 33 provides a sanction if that requirement is not met.
