#### **1 Title**

This order is the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority (Nashi/Asian Pear) Revocation Order 2016.

## 3 Revocation

The New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority (Nashi/Asian Pear) Order 1994 (SR 1994/204) is revoked.

### Explanatory note

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order, which comes into force on 30 September 2016, revokes the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority (Nashi/Asian Pear) Order 1994. The revocation is at the request of Nashi New Zealand Incorporated, which is the recognised product group for nashi/Asian pears under the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority Act 1987 (the **Act**). The effect of the revocation is that nashi/Asian pears will no longer be a prescribed product for the purposes of the Act (and so the requirement to pay an annual fee to the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority is removed).
