#### **Regulations**

- 1 Title**  
These regulations are the Trade in Endangered Species Amendment Regulations 2008.

**2 Commencement**

These regulations come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**3 Principal regulations amended**

These regulations amend the Trade in Endangered Species Regulations 1991.

**4 Fees**

- (1) Regulation 6(1) is amended by omitting “\$40” and substituting “\$80”.
- (2) Regulation 6(2)(a) is amended by omitting “\$298.75” and substituting “\$600”.
- (3) Regulation 6(2)(b) is amended by omitting “\$130” and substituting “\$260”.
- (4) Regulation 6(3) is amended by omitting “\$130” and substituting “\$260”.
- (5) Regulation 6(4) is amended by omitting “\$208.75” and substituting “\$420”.
