Regulations

- 1 Title**
These regulations are the Unsolicited Electronic Messages Amendment Regulations 2012.
- 2 Commencement**
These regulations come into force on 1 October 2012.
- 3 Principal regulations**
These regulations amend the Unsolicited Electronic Messages Regulations 2007 (the **principal regulations**).
- 4 Regulation 9 and cross-heading revoked**
Revoke regulation 9 and the cross-heading above regulation 9.
- 5 Schedule amended**
In the Schedule, revoke form 3.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 October 2012, make amendments to the Unsolicited Electronic Messages Regulations 2007 (the **principal regulations**) that are consequential on the commencement of certain provisions of the Search and Surveillance Act 2012. These regulations revoke regulation 9 and form 3 in the Schedule of the principal regulations.
