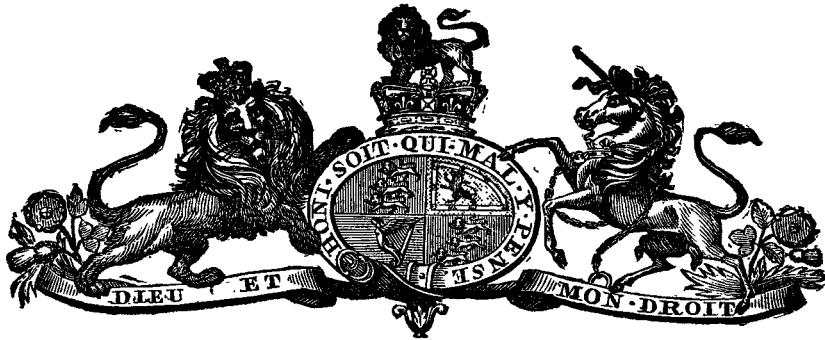

AN ACT to apply a Sum of Money out of the Consolidated Fund and other Moneys to the Service of the Year ending the Thirtieth day of June, One thousand eight hundred and seventy-three, and to appropriate the Supplies granted in this present Session. Title.  
[25th October, 1872.]

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN—We, Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects the House of Representatives of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, towards making good the Supply which we have cheerfully granted to Your Majesty in this Session of Parliament, have resolved to grant unto Your Majesty the sums hereinafter mentioned, and do therefore most humbly beseech Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted by the General Assembly of New Zealand, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:— Address.

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Appropriation Act, 1872." Short Title.

2. In addition to the sum of one hundred thousand pounds (£100,000) already authorized to be applied out of the Consolidated Fund to the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three, by "The Imprest Application of moneys.

*Appropriation.*

Supply Act, 1872," and the sum of fifty thousand pounds (£50,000) authorized to be applied out of the said Fund to the service of the said year by "The Imprest Supply Act, 1872 (No. 2)," there shall and may be applied out of the Consolidated Fund, for and towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty, a further sum of two hundred and sixty-seven thousand two hundred and twenty-nine pounds seven shillings and tenpence (£267,229 7s. 10d.) for the service of the said year.

**Appropriation of supplies.**

3. Out of all or any of the supplies or aids aforesaid there shall and may be issued and applied, in addition to all other sums of money now by law permanently appropriated, any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the amount of four hundred and seventeen thousand two hundred and twenty-nine pounds seven shillings and tenpence (£417,229 7s. 10d.) for or towards the several services and purposes specified and set forth in the several Classes and Votes in the First and Second Schedules hereto.

**Confiscated lands.**

4. Out of such portion of the Special Fund as may have arisen or may hereafter arise from the proceeds of the sale or other disposal of lands taken under "The New Zealand Settlements Act, 1863," or any Acts amending the same, there shall and may be issued and applied any sum or sums not exceeding in the whole seven thousand nine hundred and seventy-eight pounds (£7,978) for and towards the services and purposes specified in the Third Schedule hereto.

**Advances from Special Fund in aid of appropriations for confiscated lands.**

5. If the revenues accruing under "The New Zealand Settlements Act, 1863," or any Acts amending the same, shall at any time be insufficient to meet the charges thereon under this or any other Act appropriating such revenues, the Colonial Treasurer may advance out of any moneys standing to the credit of the Defence Loan, or of the Immigration and Public Works Loan, such sums as may be necessary to make up such deficiency, and all such advances shall be repaid to the said loans out of the first proceeds of the revenues accruing under "The New Zealand Settlements Act, 1863," or the Acts amending the same.

**Defence Loan.**

6. In addition to the sum of thirty thousand pounds (£30,000) authorized to be applied out of the moneys raised under "The Defence and Other Purposes Loan Act, 1870," to the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three, by "The Imprest Supply Act, 1872," and the sum of twenty thousand pounds (£20,000) authorized to be applied out of moneys raised under the said "Defence and Other Purposes Loan Act, 1870," to the service of the said year by "The Imprest Supply Act, 1872, (No. 2)," there shall and may be issued and applied out of any of the moneys authorized to be raised under "The Defence and Other Purposes Loan Act, 1870," any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole one hundred thousand pounds (£100,000) for or towards the costs charges and expenses of the services and purposes specified and set forth in the Fourth Schedule hereto.

**Salaries of Commissioners of Crown Lands.**

7. Out of the Land Fund of the Provinces for which the Commissioners of Crown Lands are respectively appointed, there shall and may be issued and applied, to defray the salaries of such Commissioners, any sum or sums not exceeding the amounts specified in the First Part of the Fifth Schedule hereto, and therein set opposite the name of the Province out of the Land Fund of which such sums are to be issued; and if the Land Fund of any Province shall be insufficient to meet such charges, the Colonial Treasurer may advance out of the Consolidated Fund such sums as may be necessary to make up such deficiency, and all such advances shall be repaid to the Consolidated Fund out of the first proceeds of such Land Fund.

*Appropriation.*

And out of the revenues accruing under the Native Lands Acts there shall and may be issued and applied, to defray the salaries and expenses of the Native Lands Court specified in the Second Part of the said Fifth Schedule, any sum or sums not exceeding in the whole four thousand five hundred and fifty-five pounds (£4,555):

Expenses of Native Lands Court.

Provided however that the said salaries and expenses of the Native Lands Court shall be charged against the several Provinces in proportion to the time during which the said Court shall have sat or shall sit in each Province during the year ending the said thirtieth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three.

And out of the said revenues there shall and may be issued and applied, to defray the salaries and expenses of the Inspector of Surveys' Department specified in the Third Part of the said Fifth Schedule, any sum or sums not exceeding in the whole three thousand seven hundred and sixty-five pounds (£3,765):

Expenses of Inspector of Surveys.

Provided that the said salaries and expenses of the said Inspector of Surveys' Department shall be charged against the several Provinces in proportion to the number of acres in each Province surveyed by such Department during the said year.

8. If the said revenues accruing within any Province under the Native Lands Acts shall be insufficient to meet the said charges, the Colonial Treasurer may advance out of the moneys authorized to be raised under "The Immigration and Public Works Loan Act, 1870," and applicable to the purchase of land in the North Island, such sums as may be necessary to meet any such deficiency.

To meet deficiency of Land Fund, advances from moneys applicable to purchase of land in North Island in aid to be charged against Province.

The balance of such advances found to be outstanding on the thirtieth June, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three, shall be charged against the Province in aid of which such advances have been made; and the interest and sinking fund payable by the Colony in respect of such advances shall be charged against such Province in the manner provided by the forty-fourth section of "The Public Revenues Act, 1867," and the fifth section of "The Public Revenues Act Amendment Act, 1871."

9. Whereas for the year ending the thirtieth day of June last the expenditure on the salaries and expenses of the Native Lands Court and Inspector of Surveys' Departments, in respect of the Province of Auckland, exceeded the amounts credited to the Land Fund of such Province, in respect of the fees fines duties and other revenues arising under the Native Lands Acts, by the sum of three hundred and twelve pounds twelve shillings and sixpence (£312 12s. 6d.):

Excess of Expenditure on Native Lands Court for 1871-72.

And whereas for the said year the expenditure on such salaries and expenses as aforesaid, in respect of the Province of Wellington, exceeded the amounts credited to the Land Fund of the Province of Wellington in respect of such fees fines duties and other revenues as aforesaid by the sum of four thousand two hundred and twenty pounds eighteen shillings and twopence (£4,220 18s. 2d.):

And whereas it is expedient that such excess should be repaid to the Land Fund of such Provinces respectively by advances from moneys authorized to be raised under "The Immigration and Public Works Act, 1870," and applicable to the purchase of land in the North Island, and that such advances should be charged against such Provinces:

Therefore it is hereby enacted, that out of the moneys authorized to be raised and applicable as aforesaid, there may be issued and applied the said several sums of three hundred and twelve pounds twelve shillings and sixpence (£312 12s. 6d.), and four thousand two hundred and twenty pounds eighteen shillings and twopence (£4,220 18s. 2d.); and the said sum of three hundred and twelve pounds

twelve shillings and sixpence (£312 12s. 6d.) shall be paid to the credit of the Land Fund of the Province of Auckland, and the interest and sinking fund from time to time payable by the Colony in respect of such advance shall be charged against the said Province in the manner provided by the forty-fourth section of "The Public Revenues Act, 1867," and the fifth section of "The Public Revenues Act Amendment Act, 1871;" and the said sum of four thousand two hundred and twenty pounds eighteen shillings and twopence (£4,220 18s. 2d.) shall be paid to the credit of the Land Fund of the Province of Wellington, and the interest and sinking fund from time to time payable by the Colony in respect thereof shall be charged against the Province of Wellington in the manner aforesaid.

Trust Fund.

10. Out of the moneys standing to the credit of the several separate accounts in the Public Trust Fund specified in the Sixth Schedule hereto, there shall and may be issued and applied the several sums specified in the said Schedule; and such sums shall be issued out of the respective accounts against which the same are charged in the Schedule, or out of the Interest Account of the said Fund.

Public works.

11. Out of any of the moneys for the time being standing to the credit of the Public Works Account, there shall and may be issued and applied any sum or sums not exceeding in the whole two hundred and ten thousand three hundred and thirty-one pounds twelve shillings and fourpence (£210,331 12s. 4d.), less twenty-one thousand five hundred pounds (£21,500) for interest and sinking fund to be charged to the Consolidated Fund, for or towards the costs charges and expenses of the services and purposes specified in the Seventh Schedule hereto.

Indemnity for unauthorized expenditure.

12. And whereas the actual expenditure for the year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two, exceeded the sum authorized by law by the sum of thirty-two thousand two hundred and seventy-one pounds six shillings and eightpence (£32,271 6s. 8d.) in respect of the services specified in the First Part of the Eighth Schedule hereto, and four thousand eight hundred and ninety-eight pounds eleven shillings and fivepence (£4,898 11s. 5d.) in respect of the services specified in the Second Part of the said Eighth Schedule, and five thousand five hundred and fourteen pounds sixteen shillings and threepence (£5,514 16s. 3d.) in respect of the services specified in the Third Part of the said Eighth Schedule hereto, and eighty-one pounds ten shillings (£81 10s.) in respect of the services specified in the Fourth Part of the said Eighth Schedule: And whereas the said expenditure in excess was reasonable and necessary: Be it therefore enacted, the several Colonial Treasurers and all persons whatsoever are hereby indemnified for the expenditure of the sums in this section hereinbefore mentioned, and the Colonial Treasurer shall receive credit in his account for the said sums accordingly.

Treasurer to issue moneys on warrant of Governor.

13. The Treasurer of New Zealand shall issue and pay the said several sums hereby appropriated to such person for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned upon such days and in such proportions as the Governor may by any warrant to be signed by him order and direct, and the payment so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of such supplies and aids as aforesaid.

Treasurer allowed credit for moneys issued in pursuance of warrant.

14. The said Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for any sum of money paid by him in pursuance of any warrant issued by virtue of this Act, and the receipt of the person to whom the same shall be so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for any such sum as shall be therein mentioned.
