An Act to amend the Apiaries Act 1927

[26 October 1956]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Apiaries Amendment Act 1956, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Apiaries Act 1927 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Regulations as to substances toxic to bees—Section sixteen of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting in subsection one, after paragraph (i), the following paragraph:

“(ii) Regulating, prohibiting, or restricting, either generally or in any specified areas or at any specified times, the application for agricultural or horticultural purposes of any specified sprays or dusts or sprays or dusts of any specified classes or descriptions that are toxic to bees:”.
