Title.

AN ACT to authorize the Auckland Harbour Board to borrow the sum of one million six hundred thousand pounds for harbour works and other purposes.

[12 November 1953

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Short Title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Auckland Harbour Board Loan and Empowering Act 1953.

Special Act.

2. This Act shall be deemed to be a special Act within the meaning of the Harbours Act 1950.

Authority to carry out harbour works.

3. The Board is hereby authorized, subject to the provisions of the Harbours Act 1950, to construct and carry out the harbour works specified in the First Schedule to this Act.

Authority to borrow.

4. It shall be lawful for the Board, from time to time as it may require, to borrow, subject to the provisions of the Harbours Act 1950 and the Local Government Loans Board Act 1926, a sum or sums of money not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of one million six hundred thousand pounds.

5. All moneys borrowed under and by the authority of this Act shall be applied and expended in the construction of the harbour works and for the other purposes specified in the First Schedule to this Act.

Expenditure on
harbour works.

6. The Board is hereby authorized to refund to the Harbour Fund, from the moneys borrowed under the authority of this Act, the amount of any moneys expended from the Harbour Fund, whether before the passing of this Act or within four months thereafter, in the carrying out or construction of any of the harbour works or other purposes specified in the Second Schedule to this Act, and any amount so refunded shall be deemed to have been applied and expended for that purpose.
