An Acr to authorise the Raising of Money in aid of certain Public Title. Works and Purposes. 29th October, 1909.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Aid to Public Works and Short Tille. Land Settlement Act, 1909.

2. This Act shall be deemed to be an authorising Act within the New Zealand meaning of the New Zealand Loans Act, 1908, and the moneys hereinafter authorised to be raised shall be raised under and subject to the provisions of that Act accordingly.

3. The Minister of Finance is hereby empowered to raise, on the Minister of security of and charged upon the public revenues of New Zealand, Finance may raise £1,000,000. such sums of money, not exceeding in the whole the sum of one million pounds, as he thinks fit.

4. The sums so raised shall bear interest at such rate (not Rate of interest. exceeding four and a half per centum per annum) as the Minister of Finance prescribes.

5. All moneys raised under the authority of this Act shall, as Moneys raised to be and when raised, be paid into the Public Account to the credit of credited to Public Works Fund, and the Public Works Fund, and shall from time to time be applied to applied for works the works and purposes specified in the Schedule hereto, in such and purposes in Schedule. amounts as are from time to time appropriated by Parliament.
