An Act to amend the Broadcasting Act 1936

[18 September 1959]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Broadcasting Amendment Act 1959, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Broadcasting Act 1936 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Broadcasting stations in certain localities—Subsection three of section fourteen of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding the following proviso:

“Provided that where in any locality the Minister establishes a broadcasting station for the purpose of relaying programmes from a commercial station, the Minister shall not be obliged to provide a service in that locality from a broadcasting station that is not a commercial station.”

3. Powers of Minister—Paragraph (f) of subsection two of section eight of the Statutes Amendment Act 1947 is hereby amended by adding the following proviso:

“Provided that the Minister may, if he thinks fit, collaborate with any society, association, or body for the purpose of producing and making available to the public by sale or otherwise gramophone records or other reproductions of any matter which the Minister is authorised to broadcast under this Act notwithstanding that the matter may not have been broadcast and notwithstanding that any such society, association, or body is formed for the purpose of pecuniary gain.”
