**An Act to amend the Bylaws Act 1910**

[10 December 1976]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

**1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Bylaws Amendment Act 1976, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Bylaws Act 1910 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

**2. Application to Minister for confirmation of bylaws**—Section 3 (4) of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the words “twelve months” and substituting the expression “3 years”.

**3. Bylaws may provide for issue of licences for part of a year**—Section 3 of the Statutes Amendment Act 1940 is hereby amended by repealing subsection (4), and substituting the following subsection:

“(4) Nothing in subsection (3) of this section shall apply to the fee payable under any bylaw made under the authority of section 386 (1) (29) of the Municipal Corporations Act 1954 or section 401 (1) (28) of the Counties Act 1956.”
