AN ACT to amend the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1924. Title.
[11th October, 1930.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Births and Deaths Registration Amendment Act, 1930, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1924 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act). Short Title.

2. (1) All entries in any register heretofore made pursuant to the provisions of subsection one of section twenty-five of the principal Act or the corresponding provisions of any former Act shall, on the passing of this Act, be deemed to be expunged and deleted. Modifying requirements of principal Act with respect to registration of births of illegitimate children.

(2) In making a certified copy of the entry in any register of the birth of an illegitimate child whose birth has been registered before the passing of this Act the Registrar-General or the Registrar, as the case may be, shall omit from such copy the word "illegitimate".

(3) In making a certified copy of the entry in any register of the birth of any child who has been legitimated, whether before or after the passing of this Act, the Registrar-General or the Registrar, as the case may be, shall omit from such copy any note in such entry made pursuant to paragraph (b) of section six of the Legitimation Act, 1908, or the corresponding provisions of any former Act.

(4) Every certified copy made pursuant to either of the two last preceding subsections shall, if otherwise correct, be deemed to be a true copy of the original entry in the register.

Repeal.

(5) Subsection one of section twenty-five of the principal Act is hereby repealed.

3. (1) If any member of the New Zealand Naval Forces dies while serving with such Forces outside New Zealand his death may, notwithstanding anything contained in the principal Act, be registered under that Act by the Registrar of Births and Deaths at Wellington.

(2) In proof of such death the Registrar may accept a certificate under the hand of an officer of the New Zealand Naval Forces, or of any other person authorized in that behalf by the Minister of Defence, or may accept such other proof of death and of the several particulars required to be registered under the principal Act as he deems sufficient.
