Title. AN ACT to regulate the Export of Butter.  
[19th November, 1907.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short Title. 1. This Act may be cited as the Butter Export Act, 1907, and shall be read together with and deemed to form part of the Dairy Industry Act, 1898.

Commencement. 2. This Act shall come into operation on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and eight.

Limit of water in butter. 3. Any person who exports or attempts to export any butter which contains more than sixteen per cent. of water commits an offence, and is liable to a fine not exceeding fifty pounds.
