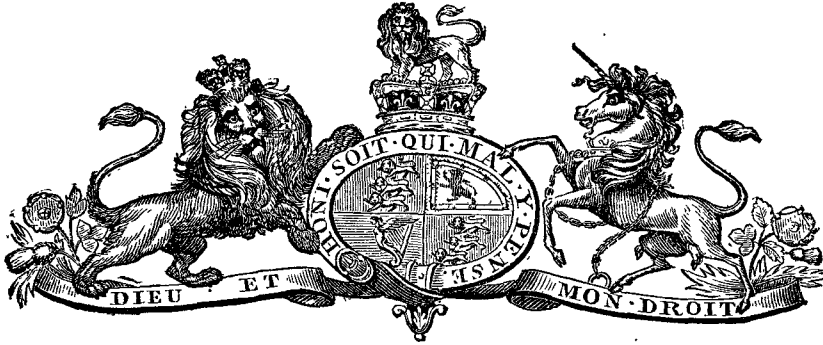

AN ACT to amend "The Bills of Sale Act 1867." Title.  
 [30th September 1868.]

**B**E IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows—

**1.** The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Bills of Sale Act 1868" It shall come into operation on the first day of November one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight. Short Title.

**2.** "The Bills of Sale Act 1867" herein referred to as "the said Act" and this Act shall so far as is consistent with the tenor of such Acts be construed together. "Bills of Sale Act 1867" and this Act to be construed together.

**3.** In any case where the personal chattels comprised in any Bill of Sale shall at the time of the making or giving of such Bill of Sale be situate at a place in the Colony not included within any Province the filing of such Bill of Sale or the copy thereof with the affidavit required by the said Act shall be effected within such time as in the said Act is provided in such Supreme Court Office as the Governor shall from time to time by Proclamation published in the *New Zealand Gazette* appoint to be the Supreme Court Office for such portion or district of the Colony to be named or defined in the Proclamation as includes such place but is not included within any Province and the Registrar or Deputy Registrar at such office shall be the officer with whom such Bills of Sale or copies thereof as in this section mentioned with the necessary affidavit shall be filed. Where place at which chattels are at time of giving Bill of Sale is not within Province Governor to fix by Proclamation the office of the Supreme Court at which Bills of Sale are to be filed.

*Bills of Sale.*

Where chattels are situate in the County of Westland Bills of Sale to be filed at the Supreme Court Office at Hokitika.

Supreme Court Offices declared to have been proper offices since 31st December 1867.

Time for filing Bills of Sale &c. extended for the future to twenty-one days.

4. In any case where the personal chattels comprised in any Bill of Sale shall at the time of the making or giving of such Bill of Sale be situate within that portion of the Colony included within the boundaries specified in the Schedule to "The County of Westland Act 1867" as the boundaries of the County of Westland the filing of such Bill of Sale of such chattels as in this section mentioned or the copy of such Bill of Sale with the affidavit required by "The Bills of Sale Act 1867" shall be effected at the Supreme Court Office at Hokitika and the Registrar or Deputy Registrar at such office shall be the officer with whom such Bill of Sale or chattels as last aforesaid or the copy of such Bill of Sale with the necessary affidavit shall be filed. And it is hereby declared and enacted that from and after the thirty-first day of December one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven until the coming into operation of this Act the said Supreme Court Office at Hokitika has been and shall henceforth be deemed to be the proper office at which and the Registrar or Deputy Registrar at such office has been and shall henceforth be deemed to be the proper officer with whom all Bills of Sale of personal chattels which at the time of the making or giving of such Bills of Sale were situate within the said portion of the Colony included within the said boundaries and all copies of such Bills of Sale with the affidavits required by "The Bills of Sale Act 1867" ought to have been filed.

5. As regards all Bills of Sale made or given after the coming into operation of this Act the times within which such Bills of Sale or copies thereof with the affidavits required by the said Act shall be filed shall be twenty-one days after the making or giving of such Bill of Sale in lieu of the time fixed by the said Act.
