AN ACT to amend "The Counties Act, 1886."

Title.

[10th June, 1887.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Counties Act Amendment Act, 1887." Short Title.

2. Section one hundred and ninety of "The Counties Act, 1886" (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act"), shall be read and construed, and shall operate and be deemed to have operated, from the date of the commencement of the said Act, as if the words "incurred by such Auditors or special Auditors" had originally been inserted in the aforesaid section in lieu of the words "incurred by such Councillors or special Auditors" where the latter words occur therein. Verbal error in section 190 of principal Act corrected.

3. Where any local authority, or the ratepayers or electors of any road district, town district, or county have acquired a derivative right to elect or nominate a member of any other public body, as mentioned in section fifty-eight of the said Act, and shall fail to do so, the Governor may nominate any person as member of such other local body at any time when such omission to elect or nominate as aforesaid is brought to his notice, notwithstanding that the proper time for electing or nominating such member may have passed. Every person so nominated by the Governor shall be a member of the local body to which he is nominated in all respects as if he had been elected or nominated thereto at the proper time and in the proper manner. On failure of exercise of derivative franchise, Governor may nominate to vacancy.

The provisions of this section shall have retrospective operation as from the date of the commencement of the said Act.

4. The Council of the County of Selwyn is hereby authorized to raise, under the authority of section two hundred and seventy-four of the said Act, a special loan, without first obtaining the consent of the Selwyn County Council may borrow £3,000 for Malvern water-race.

ratepayers of the Malvern Water-race District in the said county, for the repayment of the sum of three thousand pounds advanced from the County Fund prior to the passing of section twenty-eight of "The Counties Act Amendment Act, 1885," for the repair of an extraordinary damage done to the head-works of the Malvern water-race; and also to impose and levy a special rate on all the lands within the aforesaid district in manner as mentioned in section two hundred and seventy-three of the said Act, to secure and pay the interest on, and provide a fund for the repayment of, the said loan.
