An Act to amend the Criminal Injuries Compensation Act 1963
 [23 November 1967]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Criminal Injuries Compensation Amendment Act 1967, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Criminal Injuries Compensation Act 1963 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Power to award compensation—Section 17 of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting in paragraph (b) of subsection (1), after the word “injury”, the words “or death”.

This Act is administered in the Department of Justice.
