An Act to amend the Control of Prices Act 1947

[2 October 1958]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Control of Prices Amendment Act 1958, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Control of Prices Act 1947 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Ticketing of goods not subject to Price Orders—The principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after section forty-seven, the following section:

“47A. (1) The Minister may, from time to time, by notice published in the *Gazette*, direct that any retailers or class or classes of retailers specified in the notice who offer or expose for sale any goods specified in the notice which are not for the time being subject to a Price Order or special approval under Part II of this Act shall keep in a prominent position in such proximity to the goods to which it relates as to be obviously in relation thereto a ticket, placard, or label on which is stated in legible and prominent characters the retail price of the goods or the retail price per pound, whichever is appropriate, and any other details specified in the notice which the Minister considers necessary for identifying the goods.

“(2) The Minister may also by the same notice, or by a separate notice published in the *Gazette*, direct that any retailer or class or classes of retailers specified in the notice shall keep a statement of the retail price of any goods specified in the notice which are not for the time being subject to a Price Order or special approval under Part II of this Act prominently displayed in their shops in such a position as to be easily read by customers.”
