2. Ticketing of goods not subject to price orders

An Act to amend the Control of Prices Act 1947

[27 November 1970]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Control of Prices Amendment Act 1970, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Control of Prices Act 1947 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Ticketing of goods not subject to price orders—(1) Section 47A of the principal Act (as inserted by section 2 of the Control of Prices Amendment Act 1958) is hereby amended by omitting from subsection (2) the words “in their shops in such a position as to be easily read by customers”, and substituting the words “in such one or more places in their shops as the notice specifies”.

(2) Every notice by the Minister given under section 47A of the principal Act (as so inserted) before the passing of this Act which would be valid if this section had been in force when the notice was given is hereby validated and declared to have always been valid:

Provided that nothing in this section shall affect the rights of the parties under any judgment given in any Court before

the passing of this Act, or any judgment given on appeal from any such judgment, whether the appeal is commenced before or after the passing of this Act.

This Act is administered in the Department of Industries and Commerce.
