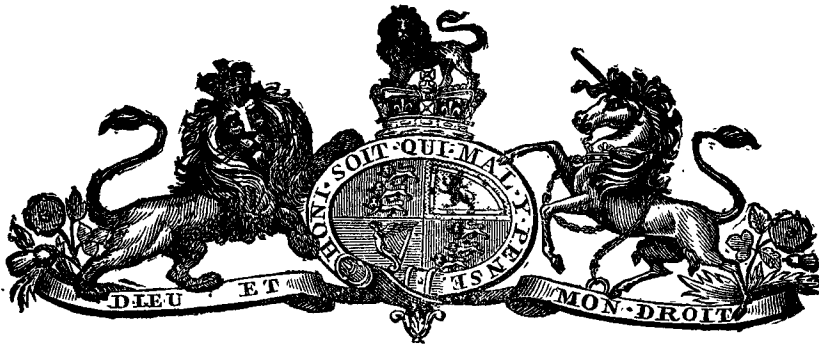

AN ACT to alter and amend "The Customs Tariff Act 1866." [10th November 1871.] Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Customs Tariff Act 1871." Short Title.

2. On and after the tenth day of November one thousand eight hundred and seventy-one there shall be levied collected and paid to Her Majesty her heirs and successors on the articles next hereinafter mentioned on importation into New Zealand or on being cleared from any warehouse for home consumption the several Duties of Customs following (that is to say) — New duties on articles herein enumerated.

3. On and after the tenth day of November one thousand eight hundred and seventy-one in lieu of the Duties of Customs chargeable under "The Customs Tariff Act 1866" on the articles next hereinafter mentioned there shall be levied collected and paid to Her Majesty her heirs and successors upon the articles next hereinafter mentioned on importation into New Zealand or on being cleared from any warehouse for home consumption the several duties following (that is to say)— Increased duties on certain articles.

“Customs Regulation Act 1858” to apply.

4. The Duties of Customs imposed by this Act shall be raised levied collected and paid under the provisions of “The Customs Regulation Act 1858” and “The Customs Regulation Act Amendment Act 1868” and subject also to all such provisions and regulations as may for the time being be in force for the collection management and receipt of the duties of import in the Colony of New Zealand.

Certain sections of “The Customs Tariff Act 1866” incorporated.

5. The sections of “The Customs Tariff Act 1866” numbered four five seven nine ten and twelve shall be deemed to be incorporated in this Act.

Drawbacks.

6. Notwithstanding the provisions of “The South Sea Islands Drawbacks Act 1870” there shall be allowed upon the exportation to any port or place out of New Zealand of goods imported into the Colony except on the goods excepted therein a drawback of the duty paid thereon but such drawback shall only be paid subject to all the conditions and provisions relating to drawbacks contained in the said above-mentioned Act and in “The Customs Regulation Act 1858.”
