AN ACT to amend the Chattels Transfer Act, 1908.

Title.

[29th October, 1919.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Chattels Transfer Amendment Act, 1919, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Chattels Transfer Act, 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

Short Title.

2. The form of affidavit prescribed for the renewal of the registration of an instrument (being the form numbered (3) in the Third Schedule to the principal Act) is hereby amended by omitting paragraph four thereof.

Third Schedule to principal Act amended.

3. Section two of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after paragraph (o) in the list of exceptions to the definition of the term "instrument," the following paragraph:—

Exempting certain documents from definition of "instrument" for purposes of principal Act.

“(p.) Mortgages or charges granted or created by a company incorporated or registered under the Companies Act, 1908, if entered in the register of mortgages of that company and registered with the Registrar of Companies pursuant to the provisions of the said Act in that behalf.”

4. Section twenty-nine of the principal Act is hereby repealed.
