An Act to amend the Christchurch Tramway District Act 1920
 [4 October 1974]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Christchurch Tramway District Amendment Act 1974, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Christchurch Tramway District Act 1920 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Allowances to members—(1) The principal Act is hereby amended by repealing section 26, and substituting the following section:

“26. The provisions of section 114A of the Municipal Corporations Act 1954 shall apply in respect of each meeting of the Board or of any committee thereof as if references in that section to a Councillor were references to a member of the Board (other than the Chairman), and as if references in that section to the Council were references to the Board.”

(2) Section 3 of the Christchurch Tramway District Amendment Act 1970 is hereby consequentially repealed.

3. Travelling allowances and expenses—The principal Act is hereby further amended by inserting, after section 26, the following section:

“26A. (1) The Board is hereby declared to be a statutory Board within the meaning of the Fees and Travelling Allowances Act 1951.

“(2) The Board may pay to the Chairman and to the members of the Board or of any committee thereof travelling allowances and expenses in accordance with the Fees and Travelling Allowances Act 1951, and the provisions of that Act shall apply accordingly.”
