AN ACT to amend "The Dunedin District Drainage and Sewerage Act, 1900." Title.
[23rd October, 1905.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Dunedin District Drainage and Sewerage Act 1900 Amendment Act, 1905"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Dunedin District Drainage and Sewerage Act, 1900" (hereinafter called "the principal Act"). Short Title.

2. The Board is hereby authorised to borrow further money for the purposes of the principal Act not exceeding in the whole the sum of one hundred thousand pounds; and section fifty-six of the principal Act shall be read and construed as if the words "three hundred thousand pounds" had been originally inserted therein instead of the words "two hundred thousand pounds." Borrowing-powers of Board increased.

3. Section forty-nine of the principal Act is hereby amended by substituting the words "one shilling" for the word "eightpence" in paragraph (1) thereof, and by substituting the word "sixpence" for the word "fourpence" in paragraph (2) thereof. Amendment of section 49 of Act of 1900.

4. Section seventeen of "The Dunedin District Drainage and Sewerage Act 1900 Amendment Act, 1902," is hereby amended by adding thereto the following subsection:— Section 17 of 1902 Act amended.

"Any work authorised by this section shall be carried out subject to such conditions (if any) as the said Minister may direct."
