AN ACT to constitute the Dannevirke Hospital District. Title
[6th November, 1924.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Dannevirke Hospital District Act, 1924, and shall commence on the first day of April, nineteen hundred and twenty-five, save that all elections, appointments, Orders in Council, notices, or regulations required for the purpose of bringing this Act into operation on that date may be held, made, or issued at any time after the passing of this Act. Short Title and commencement.

2. (1.) There is hereby constituted a hospital district under the Hospitals and Charitable Institutions Act, 1909, to be called the Dannevirke Hospital District, which shall comprise the counties of Dannevirke, Woodville, and Weber. Dannevirke Hospital District constituted.

(2.) The boundaries of the Waipawa Hospital District are hereby altered by excluding therefrom the Dannevirke, Weber, and Woodville Counties. Alteration of boundaries of Waipawa Hospital District.

3. (1.) Subject to the provisions of section nine of the Hospitals and Charitable Institutions Act, 1909, the Board of the Dannevirke Hospital District shall consist of such number of representatives of the contributory districts within the hospital district as the Governor-General, by Order in Council, from time to time determines. (2.) The first election of members of the said Board shall be held on such day as the Governor-General, by Order in Council, First election of members.

Apportionment of
assets and liabilities.

4. The Governor-General shall, by Order in Council, determine what part (if any) of the property, contracts, debts, and liabilities of the Waipawa Hospital Board, as at the commencement of this Act, shall become the property, contracts, debts, and liabilities of the Dannevirke Hospital Board, and the said Order in Council shall have effect according to the tenor thereof.
