DUNEDIN SCHOOL  
RESERVE.

AN ACT to change the Purposes of some Reserves in the City of Dunedin, and to vest the same in the Education Board of the Otago Provincial District.

[20th November, 1877.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS the parcel of land described in the Schedule to this Act, being part of the Cemetery Reserve, Dunedin, was vested in the Superintendent of Otago for the time being: And whereas a school has been erected on the said land, and it is desirable that the said land should be vested in the Education Board of the Otago Education District for the time being in trust for a site for a school in Dunedin:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short Title.

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Dunedin School Reserve Act, 1877."

Site for school.

2. The land described in the Schedule to this Act shall be and the same is hereby absolutely vested in and transferred to the Education Board for the time being of the Otago Education Board District in trust for the site of a school for Dunedin and neighbourhood.

Schedule.

## SCHEDULE.

ALL that parcel of land in the Provincial District of Otago, in the City of Dunedin, containing by admeasurement two (2) acres, more or less. Bounded towards the North-east by a line bearing 111° 43' 42", six hundred and seven (607) links, to Arthur Street; towards the South-east by Arthur Street, three hundred and thirty-three (333) links; towards the South by a recreation reserve, five hundred and fifty-six (556) links; towards the West by a road line, eighty-two and a half (82.5) links; and towards the North-west by a recreation reserve, two hundred and seventy (270) links: be all the aforesaid linkages more or less, as the same is delineated on the plans deposited in the Provincial District Survey Office, Dunedin.
