**An Act to amend the Education Act 1964**

*[1 April 1974]*

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

**1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Education Amendment Act 1974, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education Act 1964 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

**2. Fees payable to associations of students**—(1) The principal Act is hereby amended by inserting in Part II, after section 69, the following section:

“69A (1) Pursuant to such bylaws as may be made for the purposes of this section by the Board of Governors or other governing body of a technical institute, the Board or governing body shall have the power to impose and collect from time to time from students of the institute or from any of them such fees as it considers reasonable for the benefit of any association or organisation of students of the institute and to pay those fees to any such association or organisation accordingly.

“(2) For the purposes of exercising the powers contained in subsection (1) of this section, the bylaws made by the Board or governing body shall prescribe the amount of the fees to be imposed together with the mode of collection and payment, and shall contain such provisions as to relief from payment by any student on the grounds of hardship, or exemption from membership of the association or organisation on the grounds of conscientious objection to membership, as the Board or governing body thinks fit.

“(3) Subject to such exemption from membership on the grounds of conscientious objection as the bylaws of any Board or other governing body shall provide, every student shall on payment by him of the prescribed fee be deemed to be a member of the association or organisation on whose behalf the fee is collected.”

(2) Notwithstanding anything in subsection (1) of this section, and notwithstanding that bylaws may not have been made for the purposes of collecting fees payable to any association or organisation of students at a technical institute, any fees heretofore collected on behalf of the association or organisation of students by the Board or other governing body of the institute shall be deemed to have been validly collected on behalf of the association or organisation of students.
