An Act to provide that no further by-elections be held under the Electoral Act 1956 before the general election to be held in 1987 as a result of the dissolution or expiration of the 41st Parliament [8 June 1987]

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Electoral Amendment Act (No. 2) 1987, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electoral Act 1956 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. By-elections—Notwithstanding anything in section 72 of the principal Act, no writ shall be issued for a by-election to supply any vacancy now existing in the House of Representatives or any other vacancy that may arise therein before the general election to be held in 1987 as a result of the dissolution or expiration of the 41st Parliament, and no warrant shall be issued for any such writ.
