AN ACT to confer Additional Powers upon the Ellesmere Domain Board. Title.  
[3rd December, 1909.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Ellesmere Domain Board Empowering Act, 1909. Short Title.

2. The Ellesmere Domain Board may, out of funds at its disposal derived from the domain under its control, purchase, in the name of His Majesty, one or more pieces of land for public recreation purposes for such townships or villages situated within the Ellesmere Road District as the Domain Board in its discretion may hereafter from time to time decide. Power to purchase land for recreation purposes.

3. All land purchased by the Board under the provisions of this Act shall, on being conveyed to the King, be subject to the Public Reserves and Domains Act, 1908, and shall be under the control of the Ellesmere Domain Board. Land purchased subject to the Public Reserves and Domains Act, 1908.
