**An Act to amend the Emergency Forces Rehabilitation Act 1953** [8 December 1971]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

**1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Emergency Forces Rehabilitation Amendment Act 1971, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Emergency Forces Rehabilitation Act 1953 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

**2. Rehabilitation regulations**—Section 2 of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding to subsection (1) the following words “, or who, while ordinarily resident in New Zealand, serve or have served outside New Zealand during any such emergency in any of the naval, military, or air forces of any country that is an ally of New Zealand in that emergency”.

This Act is administered in the Social Security Department.
