An Act to amend the Electric Power Boards Act 1925

[27 October 1965]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Electric Power Boards Amendment Act 1965, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electric Power Boards Act 1925 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Allowances to officers—Section 48 of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:

“(4) A Board may, pursuant to a resolution in that behalf, from time to time pay to any of its officers such allowances and expenses as it thinks fit in respect of their attendance at any course of study or training which, in the opinion of the Board, will render them better fitted to carry out their duties as officers of the Board.”

3. Bank accounts—Subsection (1) of section 73 of the principal Act (as substituted by section 4 of the Electric Power Boards Amendment Act 1963) is hereby amended by inserting after the words “such bank”, the words “or banks”.
