**An Act to amend the Electrical Supply Authorities
Association Act 1930** [22 October 1959]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Electrical Supply Authorities Association Amendment Act 1959, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electrical Supply Authorities Association Act 1930 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Delegates—(1) The principal Act is hereby amended by repealing section eight, and substituting the following section:

“8. (1) Each member of the Association may from time to time appoint delegates to represent the member at any meeting of the Association.

“(2) Every delegate shall be a member of the body which appoints him.

“(3) The delegates of any member present at any meeting shall be entitled to exercise on any matter brought before the meeting the number of votes specified in this subsection, that is to say:

“(a) If the annual subscription of the member is not more than one hundred and twenty-five pounds, the delegates shall be entitled to exercise two votes:

“(b) If the annual subscription of the member is more than one hundred and twenty-five pounds but not more than one hundred and eighty-five pounds, the delegates shall be entitled to exercise four votes:

“(c) If the annual subscription of the member is more than one hundred and eighty-five pounds, the delegates shall be entitled to exercise six votes.

“(4) Any delegate present at a meeting may exercise all or any number of the votes to which the member he represents is entitled, but the delegates representing any member shall not among them exercise votes in excess of the total number to which the member is so entitled.

“(5) No delegate shall vote on behalf of more than one member at any meeting, and no delegate shall appoint a proxy to attend any meeting in his stead.”

(2) Section five of the principal Act is hereby amended as follows:

(a) By repealing subsection three:

(b) By repealing subsection four, and substituting the following subsection:

“(4) The subscriptions shall be fixed from time to time by the Association at the annual meeting.”
