AN ACT to amend "The Fraudulent Debtors Act, 1875," and to make further provision for the Punishment of Fraudulent Debtors. Title.

[30th October, 1876.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Fraudulent Debtors Act 1875 Amendment Act, 1876." Short Title.

2. Each of the several offences mentioned in the second, third, and fourth sections of "The Fraudulent Debtors Act, 1875," (hereinafter called the said Act,) shall be deemed to be an offence punishable as therein respectively mentioned if committed by any person who shall become bankrupt under the provisions of "The Debtors and Creditors Act, 1876;" and for the purposes of the said Act the expressions "the commencement of the liquidation resolution," and "the commencement of the liquidation," as used in the said sections, shall be read and construed as "the bankruptcy;" and the word "liquidation," as used in the said sections, shall be read and construed as applying to the proceedings in bankruptcy under the provisions of "The Debtors and Creditors Act, 1876." Offences under certain sections of Act of 1875 to be deemed offences under this Act.

3. Each of the several offences mentioned in the fifth section of the said Act shall be deemed to be an offence punishable as therein mentioned if committed by a creditor making any claim proof declaration or statement of account, as the case may be, under the provisions of "The Debtors and Creditors Act, 1876." Offences under 5th section to be deemed offences under this Act.

4. The word "debtor," as used in the sixth section of the said Act, shall apply to and be deemed to include a debtor under the provisions of "The Debtors and Creditors Act, 1876."

5. The seventh section of the said Act shall apply to the report of a creditors' trustee elected or appointed under the provisions of "The Debtors and Creditors Act, 1876."

6. The tenth section of the said Act shall be read as if the words "The Debtors and Creditors Act, 1876," were substituted for the words "The Debtors and Creditors Act, 1875."
