An Act to amend the Fishing Industry Board Act 1963

[22 October 1981]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Fishing Industry Board Amendment Act 1981, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fishing Industry Board Act 1963 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Contracts of Board and members—Section 30 of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after subsection (1), the following subsection:

“(1A) Where a member of the Board, who is appointed under paragraph (b) or paragraph (c) or paragraph (d) or paragraph (e) of section 3 (3) of this Act or who is appointed under section 6A or section 7 (2) of this Act in respect of a member of the Board appointed under any of those paragraphs, has, directly or indirectly, a pecuniary interest in any matter before the Board or a committee of the Board, section 6 of the Local Authorities (Members’ Interests) Act 1968 shall not prohibit the member from voting on or

taking part in the discussion of that matter where the pecuniary interest is not different in kind from the interests of other persons in the federation, association, or organisation which nominated the member appointed under paragraph (b) or paragraph (c) or paragraph (d) or paragraph (e) of section 3 (3) of this Act.”

3. Regulations—Section 35 of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding to paragraph (ca) (as inserted by section 13 (1) of the Fishing Industry Board Amendment Act 1975) the words “, providing for the payment of fees for the issue and renewal of such licences, and prohibiting the export of fish and fish products from New Zealand by persons not holding such licences”.

This Act is administered in the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries.
