AN ACT to amend the Law relating to the Establishment and Travelling Allowances of the Governor. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

| <p>2. "The Governor's Salary and Allowances Act, 1887," is hereby repealed; and it is hereby enacted that from and after the coming into operation of this Act there shall be payable to the Governor every year out of the Consolidated Fund the sum of one thousand five hundred pounds as an allowance for the salaries and expenses of his establishment; and also the sum of five hundred pounds as an allowance for the travelling-expenses of himself, his family, officers, and servants: Provided that such allowances shall not be payable for any period during which the Governor is absent from the colony.</p> | <p>Repeal.

| <p>3. An Officer administering the Government shall be entitled to the full establishment and travelling allowances of a Governor, but he shall only receive so much of the said allowances as is proportional to the time he is in office.</p> | <p>Provision during absence of Governor from colony.</p> |
| <p>4. The year referred to in section two hereof shall be deemed to be the financial year ending the thirty-first day of March; and for the period elapsing between the commencement of this Act and the thirty-first day of March next ensuing the moneys payable under that section shall be duly apportioned accordingly.</p> | <p>Appropriations for financial year.</p> |
