**An Act to amend the Harbours Act 1950**

[23 November 1967]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

**1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Harbours Amendment Act 1967, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Harbours Act 1950 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

**2. Annual allowance to Chairman**—(1) Section 36 of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing subsection (1) (as substituted by section 7 (1) of the Harbours Amendment Act 1961), and substituting the following subsection:

“(1) The Chairman may be paid such annual allowance as the Board from time to time determines, at a rate not exceeding—

“(a) In the case of the Auckland, Northland, and Wellington Harbour Boards, two thousand five hundred dollars:

“(b) In the case of the Lyttelton and Otago Harbour Boards, two thousand dollars:

“(c) In the case of the Napier, Southland, and Tauranga Harbour Boards and the Taranaki Harbours Board, one thousand five hundred dollars:

“(d) In the case of the Gisborne, Greymouth, Marlborough, Nelson, Timaru, and Wanganui Harbour Boards, one thousand two hundred dollars:

“(e) In the case of any other Harbour Board, nine hundred dollars.”

(2) Section 8 of the Northland Harbour Board Act 1965 is hereby amended—

(a) By omitting from subsection (1) the words “(as substituted by subsection (1) of section 7 of the Harbours Amendment Act 1961)”, and substituting the words “(as substituted by section 2 (1) of the Harbours Amendment Act 1967)”:

(b) By omitting from the proviso to subsection (1) (as amended by section 7 (1) of the Decimal Currency Act 1964) the words “two thousand dollars”, and substituting the words “two thousand five hundred dollars”.

(3) Notwithstanding anything in subsection (2) of section 36 of the principal Act, the allowance of the Chairman of any Board who is in office at the date of the passing of this Act may, by resolution of the Board passed within six months after that date, be increased once during his term of office.

(4) The following enactments are hereby consequentially repealed:

(a) Section 7 of the Harbours Amendment Act 1961:

(b) Section 4 of the Harbours Amendment Act 1965:

(c) So much of the Second Schedule to the Northland Harbour Board Act 1965 as relates to section 36 of the principal Act.
