**An Act to amend the Harbours Act 1950**

[2 August 1974]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

**1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Harbours Amendment Act 1974, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Harbours Act 1950 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

**2. Constitution of Harbour Boards**—The First Schedule to the principal Act (as amended by section 11 (1) of the Harbours Amendment Act (No. 2) 1971) is hereby further amended by repealing so much of that Schedule as relates to the Marlborough Harbour Board, and substituting the following:

“Marlborough Harbour Board. Twelve members

Four by the electors of the County of Marlborough, of whom 1 shall be elected by the electors of the Kenepuru and Croisilles - French Pass Ridings of the said county, 1 by the electors of the Pelorus Riding of the said county, 1 by the electors of the Spring Creek - Picton Riding of the said county, and 1 by the electors of the Omaka and Wairau Ridings of the said county; 4 by the electors of the Borough of Blenheim; 2 by the electors of the Borough of Picton; 1 by the electors of the County of Awatere; and 1 by the electors of the County of Kaikoura.”
