### 1920, No. 3.—*Local and Personal.*

AN ACT to amend the Hawke's Bay Rivers Act, 1919. Title  
[15th September, 1920.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Hawke's Bay Rivers Amendment Act, 1920, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hawke's Bay Rivers Act, 1919 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act). Short Title.

2. Section four of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing the definition of the term "the Minister." Section 4 of principal Act amended.

3. (1.) Subsection two of section twenty of the principal Act is hereby amended as follows:— Section 20 of principal Act (relating to flood-prevention loans) amended.

(a.) By omitting all words down to and including the words "Provided always that":

(b.) By omitting from the second proviso (which shall be read as subsection three of the said section) the words "Provided further that":

(c.) By omitting from the third proviso (which shall be read as subsection four of the said section) the words "Provided lastly that."

(2.) The said section twenty is hereby further amended by adding the following subsection:—

"(5.) For the purposes of this section the expression 'the Minister' means the Minister of Public Works."
