An Act to amend the Indecent Publications Act 1910

[1 December 1961]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Indecent Publications Amendment Act 1961, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Indecent Publications Act 1910* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Meaning of "indecent document"—(1) Section 2 of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding to the definition of the term "indecent document" the words "and includes any sound recording that includes any indecent matter".

(2) The principal Act is hereby further amended—

(a) By inserting in paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section 3, after the words "be printed", the words "or manufactures or causes to be manufactured":

(b) By inserting in paragraph (e) of the same subsection, after the words "indecent document", the words "or plays or causes to be played any sound recording that includes any indecent matter":

(c) By inserting in section 9, after the word “published”, the word “manufactured”.

(3) Section 3 of the principal Act is hereby further amended by inserting in subsection (1), after paragraph (f), the following paragraph:

“(ff) Plays any sound recording containing indecent matter in a public place or so that the same is heard by persons in a public place; or”.

(4) Section 13 of the Indecent Publications Amendment Act 1954 is hereby amended by inserting, after the words “printed matter” wherever they occur, the words “or sound recording”.
