**An Act to amend the Industrial Relations Act 1973**
*[13 January 1981]*

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Industrial Relations Amendment Act 1980, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Industrial Relations Act 1973 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of May 1981.

**2. Appointment of Judges**—(1) Section 37 (6) of the principal Act (as substituted by section 3 of the Industrial Relations Amendment Act 1977) is hereby amended by omitting the expression “72”, and substituting the expression “68”.

(2) Notwithstanding anything in section 37 (6) of the principal Act or in subsection (1) of this section, any Judge who is in office at the commencement of this section may, at his option, continue in office until he attains the age of 72 years.
