An Act to amend the Judicature Act 1908

[23 October 1969]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Judicature Amendment Act 1969, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Judicature Act 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. The Judges of the Supreme Court—(1) Section 4 of the principal Act (as inserted by subsection (1) of section 4 of the Judicature Amendment Act 1957 and amended by subsection (1) of section 2 of the Judicature Amendment Act 1961) is hereby further amended by omitting from subsection (1) the word “fifteen”, and substituting the word “sixteen”.

(2) Section 2 of the Judicature Amendment Act 1961 is hereby consequentially repealed.

3. Salaries of Judges—(1) There shall be paid to the Judges of the Court of Appeal and to the Judges of the Supreme Court out of the Consolidated Revenue Account, without further appropriation than this Act, salaries at the following rates:

- (a) To the Chief Justice of New Zealand, at the rate of \$13,925 a year:
 - (b) To the President of the Court of Appeal, at the rate of \$13,270 a year:
 - (c) To each of the other Judges of the Court of Appeal or of the Supreme Court, at the rate of \$12,620 a year.
- (2) The Judicature Amendment Act 1967 is hereby repealed.
- (3) This section shall be deemed to have come into force on the 15th day of June 1969.

4. Appointment of Hon. Mr Justice Henry—The Honourable Trevor Ernest Henry, who was appointed to be a Judge of the Supreme Court for a limited period on the 21st day of February 1955 and who was appointed permanently on the 23rd day of May 1955, shall be deemed for the purposes of section 76 of the Superannuation Act 1956 to have been appointed as a Judge within the meaning of section 75 of that Act on the 21st day of February 1955.
